EXPERIENCE:

- Applicants should have a minimum of 15 years' experience operating within the UK Landscape Industry or associated educational faculty.
- Full training & guidance on the judging process will be given at all stages.

JOB ROLE & TIMELINE

January	Debrief meeting held virtually, lasting approximately 2 hours to cover feedback on previous year's Awards, as well as setting timelines and expectations for the year ahead.
June	Allocation of approximately 14 entries by Events Project Manager with agreement from all Judges, taking into consideration any conflicts of interest.
July/August	 Review of allocated entries. Arranging visits with clients and entrants. Visits to take place; durations will vary depending on the geographical location & complexity of each scheme. Brief presentations to be completed to share at the deliberation meeting. Feedback uploaded to online judging platform.
End of August	Three-day deliberation meeting held at Landscape House with accommodation provided.
December	National Landscape Awards ceremony.
